



Behavior Expectations for Camp Tamarack Participants

This document outlines expected behavior for participants at Camp Tamarack. A participant is “any person, adult or Child, involved at Camp Tamarack in any capacity.” Participants and/or their parent or guardian must review this form carefully before signing it. Please note: **Failure to sign this document will result in a Child not being accepted to camp.**

Camp Tamarack in no way, shape or form tolerates acts of discrimination and/or harassment on the basis of race, national or ethnic origin, color, age, religion, sexual orientation, marital status, family status or disability.

- Emotional, physical, verbal or sexual abuse of any participant is not tolerated.
- Participants must follow all provincial and municipal laws and regulations.
- No alcohol or illegal substances may be brought to or consumed at Camp Tamarack.
- Any material deemed a “weapon” will be confiscated and the individual sent home immediately. The Camp Director, or their designate, has the right to define what constitutes a “weapon.”
- In the event of suspected “banned” materials, the Camp Director, or their designate, may perform a search of participant’s belongings, with the participant and another adult present, for the purpose of confiscation of such banned materials.
- The privacy of the participant shall be maintained at all times. No person shall disregard another’s privacy regarding personal belongings, accommodations or hygiene facilities.
- No youth participant is permitted to leave camp property without the permission of the Camp Director, or their designate.
- No participant may engage in acts of criminal or civil disobedience as outlined by the law of Canada, for example: theft, vandalism, assault, etc.
- Actions and behaviors jeopardizing the safety of a participant or the group will not be tolerated.

Any violation of this document is cause for disciplinary measures and results in discipline that may include the participant being sent home at their own, or their parent’s/guardian’s expense.

In case of expulsion, no portion of the Camp fees is refundable.

The Camp Director, in consultation with other supervisory staff, interprets these expectations. The responsible counselor has final discretion for ensuring safety by removing/excluding an individual from any activity. Exclusion for reasons of safety may be extended to other activities if the individual has not demonstrated an understanding of risks and appropriate safety guidelines; this is decided by the Camp Director.



I have read the expectations for participation and agree to comply with the above while participating at Camp Tamarack.

I further understand that any violation of these expectations may be cause for disciplinary measures, and if such results in my being sent home, it shall be done at my own expense, or the expense of my parents/guardian.
