Summer Employment Opportunity

Camp Tamarack is a residential academic summer camp for learning disabled Children and Teens. The camp is located 25km northwest of Prince Albert, Saskatchewan, Canada. For applications please contact the Tamarack office at 306-975-0855.

Qualifications: Teacher Counselors should hold a degree in the education field, or have completed their practicum and are in the last year of a degree in the education field; and a general understanding of the Adaptive Dimension in Core Curriculum.

Job Description: Each Teacher Counselor is responsible for the academic program of a small group of students. The TC is responsible to:

- ✓ Work jointly with the Camp Director to develop an individualized academic program for 5 or 6 individual campers;
- ✓ Use desired learning outcomes to prepare and teach specific lessons;
- ✓ Demonstrate creative planning and teaching, which makes learning an interesting and enjoyable experience, and utilize the natural environment to the fullest in lesson plans and in execution of those plans;
- ✓ Observe camper's progress and provide adaptations to the camper's program as needed;
- ✓ Compile a weekly written report and a final written report, outlining each camper's progress, areas of strength, and areas still requiring focus;
- ✓ Provide general care and supervision to a small group of campers in a cabin;
- ✓ Assist in providing supervision during large group activities, such as meals, campfire, and camp swim;
- ✓ Guide campers in work crews when assigned;
- ✓ Work for the common good of the camp, providing assistance to the directors and other staff as needed.

Teacher Counselors have the option of a 3 ½ week or 7-week contract, starting at the end of June. Staff members work 5 days on 2 days off per week.
